The Reverend Anna Valentin Scholarship was established in 2015 in memory of Reverend Anna Valentin, mother to Vision Ministries' founder and current presiding bishop, Bishop J. Z. Valentin, Ph.D. Bishop Valentin envisioned a scholarship that would support high-achieving high school students in Chattanooga who are exceptional in and out of the classroom. His mother was an impactful woman, whose presence positively affected everyone around her. She was dignified, strong-minded, and intelligent. Her presence filled a room and she was an outstanding leader. The Purpose of this scholarship is to provide scholarships annually to deserving high school seniors, from public schools around Chattanooga, who intend to further their education at a two or four-year college or university.

Criteria and eligibility:

- 1. Applicants **must** be graduating seniors in the year of the award.
- 2. Applicants **must** have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 (out of 4.0).
- 3. Applicants **must** be interviewed by member(s) of the Vision Ministries Scholarship Committee.
- 4. Applicants **must** be accepted and plan to enroll full-time in a college or university.

ALL applicants must submit the following to be eligible for consideration:

1. Personal Statement (should not exceed 1 page) in response to this question:

"Reverend Anna Valentin was an incredibly impactful woman. She was known for many things, but there were certain qualities that everyone could point out. She was a woman who always **expressed leadership**, taking on the role of a shepherd to those in her community. She was **service-oriented**, recognizing and meeting the needs of those around her. She was also known for being a **visionary**, a proactive and perceptive person who broke barriers in her field. As an exceptional academic, what quality listed do you most identify with, and how has that quality pushed you to achieve a personal goal that you consider meaningful?"

- a. Must be typed, double-spaced, and in 12 pt / Times New Roman font with no grammatical errors.
- 2. Activities Resume
 - a. Formatted with organizations involved, positions with a description, and the years you participated.
- One (1) Letter of Recommendation addressed to the scholarship committee
- 4. Official Transcript as of 3rd quarter with cumulative GPA and standardized test scores (ACT, SAT, AP exams, etc)
